Winifred B. "Winnie" Smith, 95, formerly of Fort Johnson, passed away Thursday March 4, 2021 at the Mountain Valley Hospice House, Gloversville, following a long struggle with Alzheimer's Disease and complications from a fall. She was recently residing at the Sara Jane Sanford Home for Women in Amsterdam.

Winnie was born in Amsterdam on June 27, 1925 a daughter of Ignatius (James) and Victoria Dolega Reyman and was a 1943 graduate of Wilbur H. Lynch High School. She was a lifelong area resident.

Mrs. Smith was employed as a secretary at the former American Locomotive Company in Schenectady for fifteen years and later became a homemaker when her first daughter was born.

She was a member of St. Stanislaus Church in Amsterdam and recently was attending The Baptist Church of Northville. Winnie was a member of the Polish American Veterans (PAV) Ladies Auxiliary. In her more active years, she enjoyed bowling, reading, and working on crossword puzzles in addition to visiting Atlantic City and the Saratoga Racino and Race Course. More recently, Winnie enjoyed her friends, family and new experiences.

On January 25, 1953, Winnie married Anthony "Charlie" Smith at St. John's Church in Amsterdam. Sadly, after 64 years of marriage, he died on July 28, 2017.

Survivors includes two daughters, Sandra Smith (Jerry Hastings) of Gansevoort and Barbara Luthi (Joe Seney) of Gloversville; a grandson,

Nicholas Luthi; step-grandchildren and -greatgrandchildren.
